

BE IT RESOLVED THAT no one shall use television or camera equipment or conduct any activity which interrupts proceedings on the floor of the House or is a danger or disruptive to members of the public (in the Speaker's judgement).

Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the following rules apply:

1. No filming on the floor of the House is permitted.
2. Only activities occurring on the floor of the House may be filmed.
3. No additional lighting or flash equipment is permitted.
4. No filming of written material on the desk of members of the House is permitted and there shall be no interception of private conversations.
5. For safety reasons, there shall be no filming or recording from the front row of the gallery.
6. Only media personnel accredited by the Speaker in consultation with the Press Gallery are permitted to shoot still or TV film from the galleries.
7. Only portable camera equipment is permitted in the gallery.

Nothing in these rules affects or shall be construed to affect the privileges and powers of the members of the House of Assembly as they have always existed.
